PATHWAYS TO GRADUATION

Act 158 of 2018 created the following five options for high school graduation. See www.education.pa.gov for more information

1 Keystone Proficiency

Score proficient or advanced on each Keystone Exam – Algebra 1, Literature, and Biology

2 Keystone Composite

Earning a composite score of 4452 on the Algebra 1, Literature, and Biology Keystone Exam, while achieving at least a proficient score on at least one of the three exams and no less than a basic score on the remaining two

3 Career and Technical

Student must pass the corresponding class for every Keystone exam in which the student scored below proficient

AND

Attain an industrybased competency certification related to the student's program of study

OR

Demonstrate a high likelihood of success on an approved industry-based competency assessment

OR

Readiness for continued meaningful engagement in student's program of study

4 Alternative Pathway

Student must pass the corresponding class for every Keystone exam in which the student scored below proficient and one of the following:

Attain one of the following established scores

- -SAT 1010
- -PSAT 970
- -ACT 21
- -ASVAB 31

Gold Level on the ACT WorkKeys ASsessment Successful complete a preapprenticeship program

Pass a dual
enrollment course in

Earn a 3 on the AP exam in the content area that the student was not proficient in the Keystone exam.

Be accepted to an accredited 4-year nonprofit institution of higher education

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5 Evidence Pathway

Student must pass the corresponding class for every Keystone exam in which the student scored below proficient

AND ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

One of the following: Attain the following score on the

-ACT WorkKeys: 630 -SAT subject test: 630

-AP Exam: 3

Successful completion of a dual enrollment course Accepted to an accredited nonprofit institution of higher education other than a 4-year institution

Attain an industry-recognized credential

AND TWO OF THE FOLLOWING

Service learning project

Score of proficient or advanced on a Keystone Exam Guarantee of full-time employment

Complete an internship or co-op

Comply with the NCAA's core courses for college-bound student athletes with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.
