School Wide Positive Behavior

The Elk Ridge School Wide Positive Behavior (SWPB) program focuses on four themes - respect, responsibility, honesty, and effort. Using these themes, direct instruction on positive behavior will be given by the classroom teachers in all areas of the school including the bus.

ST Math Online

ST Math (Spatial-Temporal reasoning) is game-based instructional software for K-12 and is designed to boost math comprehension and proficiency through visual learning. ST Math incorporates the latest research in learning and the brain and promotes mastery-based learning and mathematical understanding. The ST Math software games use interactive, graphically-rich animations that visually represent mathematical concepts to improve conceptual understanding and problem-solving skills. It is closely aligned to state and Common Core State Standards for Mathematics and integrates with core instruction.
