- 1<sup>st</sup> place = 100 points to class, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 75 points to class, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 50 points to class

- Students who plan to bring a guest who is not an OAHS student must complete a Guest form *before* ticket purchase. Guest forms can be picked up in the OAHS Main Office beginning the week of **September 9<sup>th</sup>**. Guest forms must be signed by parents/guardians of both parties, as well as school administration of both parties. The completed form must then be brought with the OAHS student to ticket sales for the tickets to be sold. Students who plan to bring a non-OAHS student guest should complete the Guest Form process the week of **9/9**.
