Important Information

GRADUATION ATTIRE: Please wear appropriate formal/semi-formal pants, shirts, dresses, and/or skirts under graduation robes. Under white gowns specifically, wear white or light-colored clothes; bright colors and prints tend to show through the robe. Graduates should wear appropriate shoes, especially avoiding heels that may be a tripping hazard when going up and down ramps and sandals that smack the heel while walking. Graduates should try on caps ahead of time to help choose a hairstyle that works best with their caps; it's a good idea to bring extra bobby pins.

 *NO SLIPPERS, FLIP-FLOPS, JEANS, OR PJ PANTS. NOTHING ADDITIONAL CAN BE CARRIED OR WORN! *

GRADUATION PRACTICE: Students must attend practice to walk in the graduation ceremony. Students who work must take off to be present for graduation practices. There is no senior release on graduation practice days. If everyone is on time, cooperative, and pays for obligations before practice, the amount of time for practice will be reduced.

OBLIGATIONS: iPad, charging block and cord, money owed for books, uniforms, fundraisers, fines, or any other debt must be paid by each senior or they will not participate in the graduation ceremony, will not receive his/her diploma, and will not have transcripts or other records sent or released. Obligations must be paid to Mrs. Lester by Tuesday, May 30th by 1PM to participate in Graduation.

COMMENCEMENT TICKETS: Each student will be given six (6) tickets for graduation on the last day of graduation practice.
