Shiloh by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor FIC NAY	AR Level: 4.4 AR Points: 4		When he finds a lost beagle in the hills behind his West Virginia home, Marty tries to hide it from his family and the dog's real owner.

Love That Dog by Sharon Creech FIC CRE	AR Level: 4.5 AR Points: 1		A young student, who comes to love poetry through a personal understanding of what different famous poems mean to him, surprises himself by writing his own inspired poem.
Bailey's Story by Bruce Cameron <i>Series: A Dog's Purpose</i> FIC CAM	AR Level: 4.5 AR Points: 5		When Bailey meets eight-year-old Ethan, he quickly figures out his purpose: to play with the boy, to explore the Farm during summers with the boy, and to tidy the boy's dishes by licking them clean (only when Mom isn't watching). But Bailey soon learns that life isn't always so simple--that sometimes bad things happen--and that there can be no greater purpose than to protect the boy he loves.

Trouble is, her older brother Levi and his friends also want to get ahold of the pigeon, along with a host of others; in fact, it seems the entire population of tiny Meadville, South Carolina, has designs on that pesky pigeon. Winnie's Great War by Lindsay Mattick FIC MAT	AR Level: 4.8 AR Points: 4		An imagining of the real journey undertaken by the extraordinary bear, from her early days in the Canadian forest to her travels with the Veterinary Corps across the country and overseas, all the way to the London Zoo, where she met Christopher Robin Milne and inspired the creation of Winnie-the-Pooh.
The Capture by Kathryn Lasky <i>Series: Guardians of Ga'Hoole</i> FIC LAS	AR Level: 4.8 AR Points: 7		A band of owls go on a quest for the mythic Great Ga'Hoole Tree in an attempt to acquire the powers that will enable them to defeat the evil which threatens their kingdom.
Maybe a Fox by Kathi Appelt FIC APP	AR Level: 4.9 AR Points: 5		When her sister Sylvie goes missing on a snowy morning and is never seen again, Jules refuses to believe she is gone forever, meanwhile, in the shadow world, a shadow fox is born.

Wolf Hollow by Lauren Wolk FIC WOL	AR Level: 4.9 AR Points: 9		Twelve-year-old Annabelle must learn to stand up for what's right in the face of a manipulative and violent new bully who targets people Annabelle cares about, including a homeless World War I veteran.
Blue Mountain by Martine Leavitt FIC LEA	AR Level: 5 AR Points: 4		Mankind encroaches upon the bighorn sheep's habitat; wolf and puma feed on their dwindling herd. Biggest lamb Tuk must save the herd by finding a way west to "blue mountain," a place he sees in visions and may not be real. With its omniscient third-person narrator and mythic feel, the book celebrates the power of story and the beauty of the mountain world.
The Mouse with the Question Mark Tail by Richard Peck FIC PEC	AR Level: 5.0 AR Points: 4		The tiniest mouse in the Royal Mews is such a mystery he doesn't even know his own name! He scampers off on an epic adventure in and around Buckingham Palace with a plan to seek the advice of Queen Victoria. The exhilarating journey takes him to strange and wonderful places, but will it help him discover who he is and where he came from? This delightful follow-up to the acclaimed <i>Secrets at Sea</i> from Newbery Medal winner Richard Peck is full of laughs, surprises and excitement.
My Big Fat Zombie Goldfish by Mo O'Hara FIC OHA	AR Level: 5 AR Points: 4		After Tom rescued Frankie the goldfish from his big brother Mark's toxic science experiment by zapping him back to life with a battery, Frankie somehow became a BIG FAT ZOMBIE GOLDFISH with dangerous hypnotic powers. Fortunately, Frankie has appointed himself Tom's bodyguard, and together, with a little help from their friends, they thwart Mark's Evil Scientist plans.

When a winter storm separates him from his family, Toaff must make his own way in the world. It's a world filled with danger--from foxes and hawks and cats to cars and chainsaws. But also filled with delight--the dizzying scent of apple blossoms, the silvery sound of singing, the joy of leaping so far you're practically flying. I, Freddy by Dietlof Reiche <i>Series: Golden Hamster Saga</i> FIC REI	AR Level: 5.1 AR Points: 4		Freddy, a remarkably intelligent golden hamster, learns how to read and how to write on a computer and escapes captivity to become an independent and civilized creature.
Harriet the Invincible by Ursula Vernon <i>Series: Hamster Princess</i> FIC VER	AR Level: 5.1 AR Points: 2		Never a conventional princess, Harriet becomes an adventurer after learning she is cursed to fall into a deep sleep on her twelfth birthday, but after two years of slaying ogres, cliff-diving, and more with her riding quail, Mumfrey, things go awry at home and she must seek a prince to set things right.
The Cheshire Cheese Cat by Carmen Agra Deedy FIC DEE	AR Level: 5.1 AR Points: 6		A community of mice and a cheese-loving cat form an unlikely alliance at London's Cheshire Cheese, an inn where Charles Dickens finds inspiration and Queen Victoria makes an unexpected appearance.
Young Fredle by Cynthia Voigt FIC VOI	AR Level: 5.1 AR Points: 8		Fredle, a young mouse cast out of his home, faces dangers and predators outside, makes some important discoveries and allies, and learns the meaning of freedom as he struggles to return home.
True Blue by Jane Smiley FIC SMI	AR Level: 5.1 AR Points: 11		In 1960s California, eighth-grader Abby Lovitt has trouble with True Blue, the newest horse on her family's ranch, a beautiful dappled gray who is so often spooked, Abby wonders if he is haunted by the ghost of his deceased former owner.
Song For a Whale by Lynne Kelly FIC KEL	AR Level: 5.3 AR Points: 9		Twelve-year-old Iris and her grandmother, both deaf, drive from Texas to Alaska armed with Iris's plan to help Blue-55, a whale unable to communicate with other whales.

A Good Horse by Jane Smiley FIC SMI	AR Level: 5.3 AR Points: 10		On her family's California horse ranch in the 1960s, eighth-grader Abby Lovitt faces the possibility of giving up her beloved colt, Jack, when it comes to light that his dam might have been stolen.
Everything For a Dog by Ann M. Martin FIC MAR	AR Level: 5.4 AR Points: 7		In parallel stories, Bone, an orphaned dog, finds and loses a series of homes, Molly, a family pet, helps Charlie through the grief and other after-effects of his brother's death, and lonely Henry pleads for a dog of his own.

The Sign of the Cat by Lynne Jonell FIC JON	AR Level: 5.4 AR Points: 13		Duncan, eleven, is very smart with the rare ability to speak Cat, but his mother has always insisted he appear only average, and when a perfect test score draws attention to him, he not only discovers the wisdom of his mother's rules, he finds himself crossing the seas on a quest for his true identity.
Belly UP by Stuart Gibbs Series: FunJungle FIC GIB	AR Level: 5.6 AR Points: 10		Twelve-year-old Teddy investigates when a popular Texas zoo's star attraction--Henry the hippopotamus--is murdered.
The Royal Rabbits of London by Santa Montefiore FIC MON	AR Level: 5.7 AR Points: 4		When shy, quiet Shylo overhears the plan of a band of ratzis to embarrass the Queen, he must travel to Buckingham Palace and convince the Royal Rabbits of London to stop them.

Return to the Willows by Jacqueline Kelly FIC KEL	AR Level: 6 AR Points: 8		In this sequel to Kenneth Grahame's classic "The Wind in the Willows," the escapades continue for four animal friends who live along a river in the English countryside--Toad, Mole, Rat, and Badger.
Oh, Rats! by Tom Seidler FIC SEI	AR Level: 6 AR Points: 9		A New Jersey squirrel named Phoenix teams up with a pack of rats in New York City to save their riverside home from being demolished and turned into a high-rise.
The Nine Lives of Jacob Tibbs by Cylin Busby FIC BUS	AR Level: 6.1 AR Points: 11		The story of cat Jacob Tibbs, runt of the litter, and his exploits on the high seas as a ship's mouser.
