

Delaware County Community College (DCCC) Dual Enrollment Information

1. **Apply Today and Begin your Dual Enrollment Journey!**

- Remember your username and password for future use. If you aren't ready to apply and would like more information, please view our [academic programs](#) or check out our [upcoming events](#) for tour dates!

After submitting your application, wait 72 business hours and then log back into the [application portal](#) to determine if your application has been processed.

2. **Create Your Plan to Pay for Dual Enrollment Classes!**

- High school students are ineligible for financial aid as a high school diploma (or GED) is needed for financial aid. However, high school dual enrollment students receive a [dual enrollment discount](#) and can pay using a [payment plan](#).

Students will want to keep in mind the discounted cost and any non-refundable fees to determine if a payment plan is a good option for them.

3. **Complete Course Placement!**

- Determining the right level of English and math courses will greatly increase your chances of success. This step is required before you can register for classes.
- Look to see if you have [qualifying test scores](#) to waive or exempt you from the course placement test. To schedule a testing session, contact the Testing Center at testingcenter@dccc.edu or call 610-325-2776

4. **Complete the New Student Orientation!**

- Becoming acquainted with student resources and services is the key to success at DCCC. New Student Orientation (NSO) is required for all students who are new to college. Upon FULL completion of [New Student Orientation](#), you will receive a Certificate of Completion.

5. **Register for Courses!**

- Congratulations! You're ready to receive academic advising and select your courses.
- Academic advising and course registration is available by appointment either virtually (on Zoom) or in person at any of our campuses. To schedule an appointment with an academic advisor, contact the Career & Counseling Center at 610-359-5324.

Depending on your test scores a college advisor or an enrollment representative will register you for a college course. Please note: only seniors in high school may enroll in developmental courses. Only Open Dual Enrollment Students may register for classes or be registered through Career and Counseling. Structured Pathway or College in the High School students will be registered through the Admissions Department.

6. Pay your Bill!

- It is important to make sure your bill is covered by the published due date! View or pay your bill at dccc.edu/view-your-bill (delaGATE login required). Students may access their college schedule by logging onto delaGATE, clicking “Students” and then “View Your Class Schedule.”
