Admission Requirements

You must be a rising junior or senior, or a 2023 high school graduate and demonstrate readiness for college-level coursework. Please note, all students will also be required to have a computer to do online work. Minimum Requirements are:

- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater
- Completed Algebra II (with a C or higher)
- Completed Biology with lab (with a C or higher)

If you are currently in Algebra 2 or Biology, please send current grade in course.
