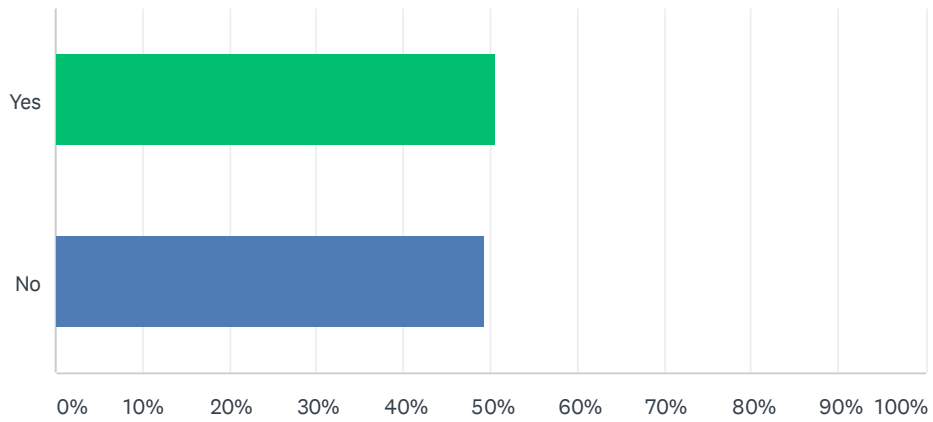


Q1 Did you attend one of the parent information sessions offered by our Technology Department for the use of Teams?

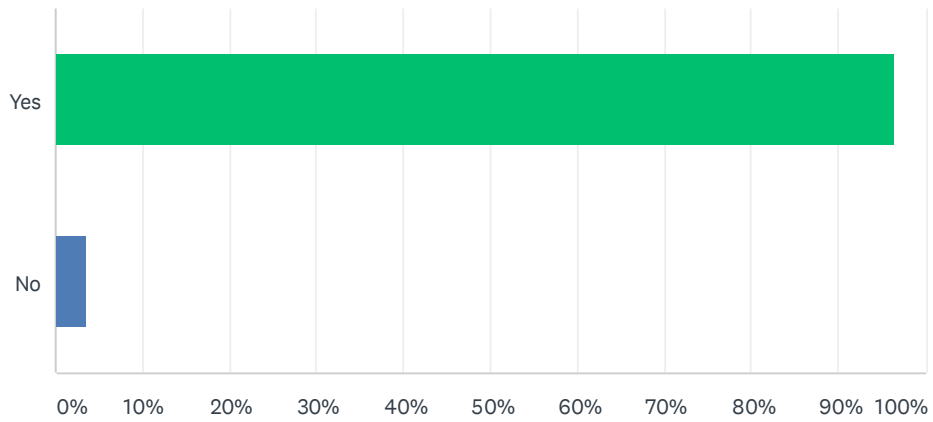

Q2 Have you (your child) been able to connect to the education programs offered by the district?

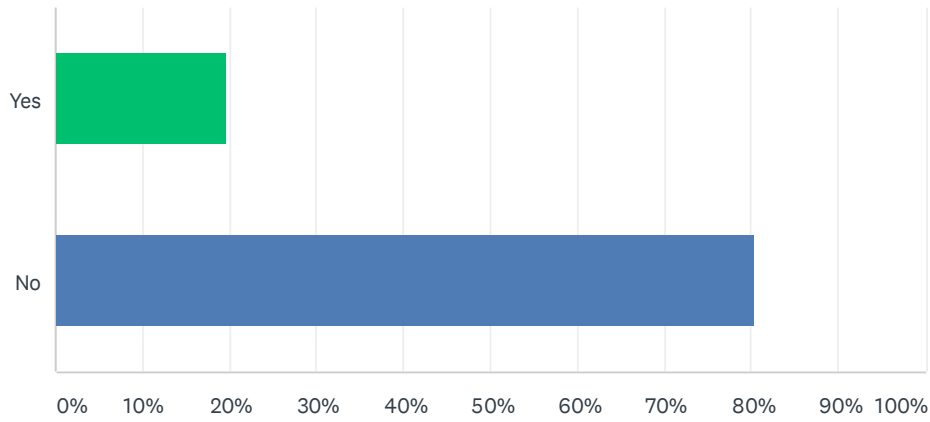

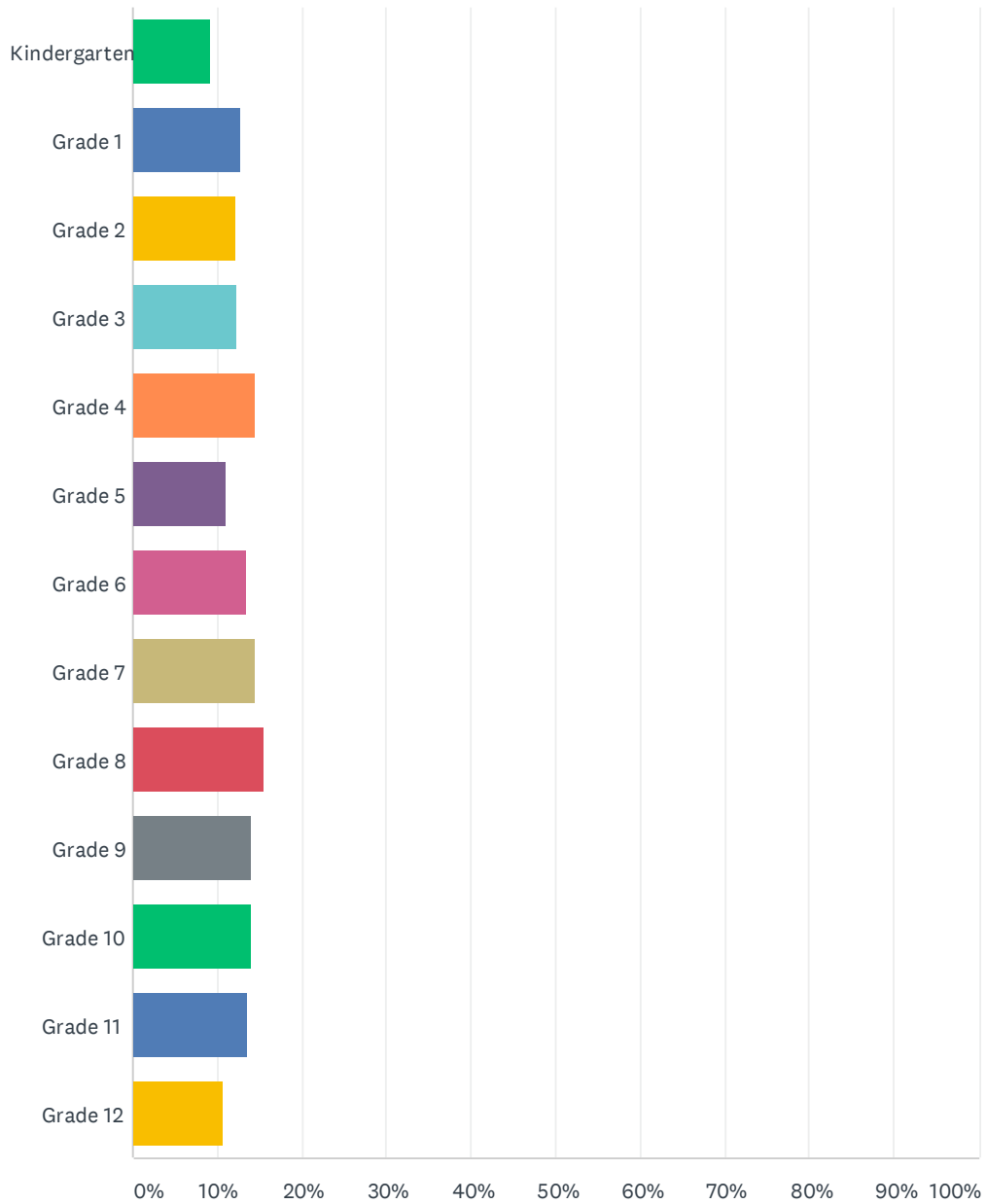
