- Must have participated in a minimum of 40 hours of community service within the last 12 months.
- Must have a letter from an authorized representative associated with the community service activity verifying the student’s participation.
- Must have the name of a high school teacher making a recommendation for the student for this scholarship.
- Application must include a 300-500 word essay on the impact his/her efforts had on the community and how this experience influenced the student’s future.
- Student cannot be an employee, a relative of an employee or volunteer of Sun East Federal Credit Union.
- Submit completed application to high school guidance counselor. Check your school’s application deadlines.
