Race/Ethnicity Information

White: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.

Black or African American: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.

Hispanic or Latino: A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

Asian: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.

American Indian or Alaska Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America), and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community attachment.

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

U.S. Citizenship and Immigrant Service Definitions

U.S. Citizen: is an individual born in the United States, Puerto Rico, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, or Swain's Island. U.S. citizens are also individuals granted citizenship status by Immigration and Naturalization Services (INS).

U.S. Permanent Resident: is a person who has been granted permission to remain in the U.S. indefinitely, so long as they continue to meet the qualifications or elect to relinquish the status. These individuals are also known as 'green card' holders.

Non-U.S. Citizen (Resident Alien or Foreign): is a person who is in the United States on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely.
