9120. BOARD COMMITTEES
Establishment

It shall be the responsibility and duty of the Board President to establish standing committees and ad hoc committees as necessary to efficiently and effectively conduct the business of the Board. The following general guidelines shall govern the establishment and operation of Board committees.

- A. Standing committees of the Board will remain committees of the Board until an interest emerges among the majority of the Board to disband a standing committee.
- B. Standing committees will report committee activity at the regular Board business meeting and will occupy a position on the agenda for the regular business meeting.
- C. Ad hoc committees may be established to address issues for which no standing committee exists. Progress on the issue for which the ad hoc committee had been established will be reported to the full Board at a Board work session.
- D. Ad hoc committees shall remain in existence so long as the issue for which it was founded remains unsettled. The Board president shall announce that the work of the ad hoc committee is complete and that the committee is disbanded.
