OXFORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT

It shall be the policy of the Oxford Area School District, in accordance with the provisions of the Public School Code, that all professional and support staff, student teachers, volunteers and persons providing services to school children shall provide proof that he/she is free of active tuberculosis. This proof can be submitted by one of the following methods:

- 1. Submitting results of a tuberculin skin test performed by a physician of the employee's or volunteer's choice. The tuberculin skin test shall be administered within three (3) months prior to the date the district receives the form. These results must indicate either of the following:
 - A non-significant tuberculin skin test reaction A significant tuberculin skin test reaction, with a negative chest x-ray for current tuberculosis disease

2. Submitting a form from the physician of the candidate's choice stating that the applicant is free of active infectious tuberculosis disease and that the candidate is at no risk at transmitting the disease to others.
