## **OXFORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT**

- A. All requests for permission for visiting foreign exchange students to attend the Oxford Area Schools shall be submitted in writing to the Superintendent of Schools and must be on the Council of Standards for International Travel (CSIET) Travel Advisory list. This request should be submitted by the sponsoring organization prior to any commitments to house the students in the district. The Superintendent of Schools shall notify the sponsors as to acceptance or denial of the request.
- B. Foreign exchange students shall comply with all immunization requirements for students. Once admitted, all exchange students shall be subject to all district policies and regulations governing students.
- C. In any one year the maximum number of foreign exchange students enrolled in a particular school shall be three. Exceptions to this maximum number will be made only by the Board of School Directors.
- D. Foreign exchange students may graduate from the Oxford Area High School if they have met all of the school's requirements for graduation. Request for graduation must be secured through the High School Principal at the initial registration of the student.
- E. Foreign exchange students who are considered members of the Senior Class and cannot meet graduation requirements may receive certificates of attendance in lieu of a diploma and may participate in all graduation ceremonies.
